Junior Skills Challenge (Monday 12:45-1:30pm): open to all juniors who would like to compete in the Golf Canada National Junior Skills Challenge)

Tee Times with Coordinators: Tee times will be open every Monday afternoon for junior golfers to play with Junior Golf Coordinators.

Wednesday Morning activities: Each week we will split into 2 groups - one group will play the 7 hole junior course from 9am to 10:30am then participate in a clinic from 10:30am till noon. The other half of the group will have the clinic first then play the junior course. Everyone will get together for a small meal just before noon at a cost of \$2.

NEW FOR 2019: Gowan Brae Junior 3 day Camps

Included with your junior membership is a 3 day junior camp. The 3 days camps will take place on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and run from 9:00am to 4:00pm. You can choose one of 3 weeks which start on either July 2nd, July 9th or July 16th.

These 3 day camps will offer a full day of activities which will include golf clinics, playing golf and fun activities. Juniors will be supervised from 9am to 4pm.

There is a maximum of 25 juniors per camp. They will be filled on a first come first serve basis.

Gowan Brae Golf & Country Club Junior Rules

- Junior-Juniors (ages 8-10) must be accompanied by an adult member and tee off during the designated junior tee-off times given below.
- Available junior tee off times:
 - During school year: After school - before 4:30pm & after 7pm
 - Summer weekdays: Between 10:00am and 3:00pm and after 7:00pm
 - Weekends & Holidays: After 3:00p.m
- Boys with established handicaps less than 18 and girls with established handicaps less than 25 may be approved by instructors to play at any time.
- Minimal age to be eligible for Junior-Junior membership is 8 years old in reference to the school calendar.

What to wear

- Collared golf shirt
- Shorts or pants
- Golf Shoes or sneakers
- The dress code is important as it represents not only our juniors but also Gowan Brae Golf Course.

What NOT to wear

- Short Shorts
- Ripped/damaged clothing
- Sweatpants

Competitive Junior Program for 2019

The program will start the week of April 29th and finish June 22nd. This is an 8 week program that will have 2 practice sessions per week, one session after school during the week and one on the weekend. This is designed for a junior golfer who wants to compete at the NB East Coast Junior Championship June 25-26 and/or the NB Junior Provincial Championship July 2-4.

The program will focus on preparing junior golfers for province competition and will include a field trip to Hampton Golf Course (host of 2019 junior provincials) for an additional practice round in June.
